

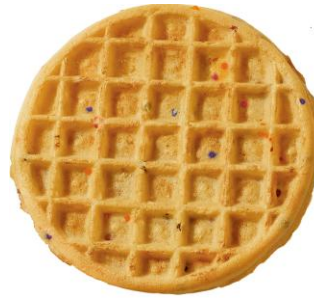

Preparation Instructions

Note: Can start from frozen or thawed, but waffles will separate easier when at least partially thawed.

- Pre-heat the oven to 375°F (convection, medium fan), 375°F (combi-oven dry heat only, no moisture), or 400°F (conventional oven).
 - Separate 24 Eggo® Froot Loops® Waffles and line up on a full sheet pan in rows of 6 to 8pc. each, overlapping the first layer by no more than 1/2".
 - Bake in the oven for 7-8 minutes, either frozen or thawed.
 - Once heated through, store in a heated cabinet at 160°F for no more than 20 minutes uncovered.
- GRILL: Heat at med-high (~375°F) setting for 2 minutes per side.

CAUTION: Use care when heating this product. Heated product may be too hot to handle.
